

Conflict Minerals Statement (3TG)

Dodd-Frank Act Section 1502 & EU Regulation 2017/821

Applicable frameworks: Dodd-Frank Act Section 1502 (USA) and Regulation (EU) 2017/821.

This statement concerns the 3TG minerals tin (Sn), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W) and gold (Au) and their ores.

We, Rainer Schneider Kabelsatzbau und Konfektion GmbH & Co. KG, are committed to responsible sourcing of raw materials and reject any form of direct or indirect financing of armed conflicts or human-rights violations through the trade in minerals.

1. Legal framework

Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act imposes due-diligence and disclosure duties on US-reporting companies for conflict minerals from the DR Congo and adjoining countries. Regulation (EU) 2017/821 has established due-diligence duties for Union importers of 3TG from conflict-affected and high-risk areas (CAHRAs) since 1 Jan 2021.

2. Our position as a downstream company

As a cable assembler we belong to the downstream industry; the binding due-diligence duties of Reg. (EU) 2017/821 currently do not apply to us. We commit to voluntary due diligence based on the following principles:

- ▶ **Supplier base:** Sourcing exclusively from reputable manufacturers and established distributors with recognised compliance standards.
- ▶ **CMRT:** We accept the Responsible Minerals Initiative's Conflict Minerals Reporting Template in its current version — presently CMRT 6.6 (17 Apr 2026) — as the standard format for customer enquiries and provide our company CMRT on request.
- ▶ **EMRT:** For extended minerals (incl. cobalt, mica, copper, lithium, nickel) we accept the Extended Minerals Reporting Template — presently EMRT 2.11 (17 Apr 2026).
- ▶ **Risk assessment:** We follow up on any indication of conflict minerals in supplied parts and take appropriate measures.
- ▶ **State of knowledge:** We currently have no information that conflict minerals financing conflicts or human-rights violations are used in our supply chains.

3. Supply-chain due-diligence duties of our customers

Many of our customers are subject to the German Supply Chain Act (LkSG) or comparable legislation and, progressively, the EU CSDDD. As a supplier we support our customers in fulfilling these duties with the formats named above.

4. Data basis

This declaration is based on data from our supply-chain partners; no express or implied warranty is associated with it. We will update the declaration in the event of changes to the legal situation or new findings from the supply chain.

We maintain a regular dialogue with our suppliers in order to react to future substance restrictions.
